### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

In 1997, the Water Bureau (Water) purchased a FileNet document imaging system. In 2008 it was upgraded it to an IBM FileNet/P8 Enterprise Content Management (ECM) System. IBM makes software updates and upgrades, for the ECM system, available to the City through an existing software maintenance agreement; however, IBM does not provide installation services for these updates and upgrades. Water now requires the ECM system be Windows 7 compliant and expert assistance is required to customize, configure, administer, maintain and support it.

In August 2011, Procurement Services issued Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 113027, in accordance with City Codes Section 5.68, to solicit the services of a qualified vendor with IBM-certified and Microsoft-certified personnel to install the ECM system updates and upgrades as well as provide additional services as identified by Water. Two proposals were received and Prescient Information Systems (Prescient) was the highest scoring bidder and was selected.

### 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The total, not-to-exceed value of this contract is \$475,000.00. Water will request \$100,000.00 per fiscal year (FY) budget for the first four years of the contract and \$75,000.00 will be requested the last FY of the contract.

Authorize a five-year contract, not-to-exceed \$475,000.00 with Prescient in support of the IBM FileNet/P8 ECM system.
