7.BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) requested the creation of the new classification of Parking Pay Station Analyst in order to more accurately describe the specific responsibilities assigned to a single incumbent position responsible for participating in the planning, implementing and evaluating of parking pay station-related projects, including technology upgrades requiring specialized knowledge of the City's wireless parking pay station technology. The Bureau of Human Resources is recommending a nonrepresented salary grade 7 for the Parking Pay Station Analyst.

8.FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no direct cost to create this new classification. One regular, full-time position, already classified grade 7, will be reclassified to the new classification, with no increase in cost.
