The Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) has requested to add an SUV for transporting emergency team equipment to incident locations. The purchase price is estimated at \$31,000 and PBEM will provide funding for the purchase of this equipment. Based on estimated usage, the repair and maintenance expenses are estimated to be \$2,545 and annual fuel costs totaling \$2,350 per year. Annual replacement costs will be \$3,092. Charges for replacement, fuel and repair services occur in accordance with the interagency agreement between CityFleet and PBEM. The present interagency agreement for FY 2013 does not include operational costs associated with this vehicle and the agreement will have to be adjusted upon receipt of the new equipment.
