

ORDINANCE No. 185362

*Amend a grant from the Environmental Protection Agency to approve budget revisions and extend the budget period to 12/31/2014 for Innovative Wet Weather Projects (Ordinance: amend Ordinance 177010)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) applied for a grant amendment to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for Innovative Wet Weather Projects on January 26, 2012; and
2. EPA has notified the City of Portland that it will approve no-cost budget revisions and extend the budget period to 12/31/2014 for Innovative Wet Weather Projects to BES, by amendment to the original grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant amendment from EPA for Innovative Wet Weather Projects in substantially the same form as the attached exhibit for this purpose.
- b. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- c. The Director of BES of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by EPA for Innovative Wet Weather Projects grant, #97045801-6-XP, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant.
