- 2. Additional work is necessary as described in the Scope of Work as follows:

Continue work with Portland School District Liaisons to gather input and implement partnerships with the City as a Portland Plan strategy as follows:

- Explore locations of new school facilities to activate neighborhood centers and optimize accessibility by transit, walking and bike.
- Explore regulatory flexibility for school districts to adapt to enrollment changes, technological
 advances and other emerging needs while anticipating and responding to neighborhood
 concerns and impacts.
- Review issues related to private and charter schools in neighborhoods.
- Review potential for shared use of public school grounds and facilities and Portland parks and community centers for multipurpose and intergenerational use.

Perform tasks to support Education and Youth Success Policy Work group as follows:

- Assist BPS to facilitate organization, orientation, meeting scheduling, agendas and notices, facilitation, reporting and other tasks to support work group in coordination with BPS staff.
- Coordinate input of Portland Public and East Portland school district superintendents and facilities managers. Represent the districts' views in deliberations of the policy expert group.
- Working in collaboration with BPS staff, develop draft policies related to school facilities planning, accommodating future growth, joint use of facilities and related matters.
- Assist BPS in implementing Portland Plan action items related to schools, including but not limited to developing intergovernmental agreements.
- Assist BPS in developing tools to implement Comprehensive Plan policies related to schools, including but not limited to school siting and zoning code changes.

3. Additional compensation is necessary and shall not exceed \$40,000.

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All other terms and conditions shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
