

ORDINANCE No. 185385

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the SE 162nd and SE Stark Sidewalk Infill project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) was allocated resources for infilling sidewalks on major arterials in Southwest and East Portland.
2. In East Portland, PBOT refined sidewalk corridors for selection through the East Portland In Motion process.
3. SE Stark and SE 162nd are high traffic streets with transit that also lack sidewalk connectivity in places on the corridor.
4. PBOT has designed the sidewalk infill project and is preparing to bid the SE Stark and SE 162nd projects to begin to provide pedestrian benefits in this underserved area.
5. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 2011-2012 and proposed FY 2012-2013 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is moderate as the project is defined and plans and specifications are complete.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00327 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


