

ORDINANCE No. 185429

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Rose City Sewer Rehabilitation Project E10104.C60 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has completed the design of the Rose City Rehabilitation Project. The project involves work in eight different areas within the City limits. Within these areas, approximately 11,500 feet of seriously deteriorated combined sewer pipe must be repaired or replaced.
2. BES has prepared plans and specifications for replacing the deteriorated sewer pipe including manholes, service laterals, stormwater inlets and inlet pipe.
3. Environmental Services requires the furnishing of labor and materials to construct this project.
4. The estimated cost is \$6,100,000 with an optimal level of confidence. Funds are available in the Sewer Operating Fund, FY 12/13 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS E10104.C60.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
