Minimal to no traffic impact is anticipated for the traveling public. The storm sewer improvements will benefit the local businesses by addressing the long time drainage issue at the project site while the street improvements will replace the existing deteriorated bridge as well as increase pedestrian and bicyclist safety through the area.

- 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS: Ordinance Number 185267 adopted on April 18, 2012 authorized a contract and provided for payment for the N Burgard Rd Over Abandoned Railroad and N Burgard Rd Storm Sewer Project. The purpose of this project is to demolish a bridge over an abandoned railroad and filling the area with engineered fill. A new sewer line is also to be constructed to dispose of storm water from the new street improvements which also includes freight, pedestrian and bicycle facilities.
- 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT: The engineer's estimate for this project was \$3,005,000.00 and the confidence level was High. Funding for this project is available in the Bureau of Transportation, Fiscal Year 2011-2012 through Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Budget, under owner cost centers T00051.
- 9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED: Accept recommendation to award the contract to Tapani Underground, Inc. in the amount of \$2,750,371.50.

- 10. <u>SCOPE OF WORK ON PROJECT:</u> The N Burgard Rd Over Abandoned Railroad & N Burgard Rd Storm Sewer project involves the removal of a bridge, the construction of street improvements and the construction of storm sewer pipe improvements along the following streets:
 - Bridge Removal and street improvements: N Burgard Rd, 165 feet north of N Terminal Rd to 560 feet north of N Terminal Rd.
 - Storm sewer improvements: N Terminal Rd, 2,350 feet east of N Burgard Rd to N Burgard Rd and N Burgard Rd from N Terminal Rd to 555 feet north of N Terminal Rd.
