#### 2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

This Ordinance postpones the effective date of amendments to Title 33, Chapter 33.430 and the repeal date of the Smith and Bybee Lakes Natural Resource Management Plan. On October 19, 2011, the City Council adopted the *Smith & Bybee Lakes Project – Recommended Draft*, which adopted changes to Title 33, Chapter 33.430 and deleted Map 430-10 concerning Smith and Bybee Lakes

Ordinance No. 184944 expressly postponed the effective date of amendments to Chapter 33.430, including deletion of Map 430-10, and repeal of the Smith and Bybee Lakes Natural Resources Management Plan (NRMP) for nine months to allow adequate time to prepare and approve a Comprehensive Natural Resources Plan (CNRP) to replace the NRMP. <u>Ordinance 184944 directed staff</u> to return to Council to extend the effective dates if a CNRP is not approved prior to the effective date.

Metro is in the process of preparing a Comprehensive Natural Resources Plan (CNRP) to submit to the City for review and approval in July 2012. The land use review process for the CNRP takes several months and will not be completed by the time the amendments to Chapter 33.430 and repeal of the NRMP are scheduled to become effective. As a result it is necessary to again postpone the effective date for amendments to Chapter 33.430, including repeal of Map 430-10, and postpone the repeal date for the NRMP.
