## ORDINANCE No. 185460

\*Accept a grant in the amount of \$26,500 from Oregon Health Sciences University and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement for the Marquam Hill Traffic Calming Project - Phase II. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) applied to Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU) for a grant in the amount of \$26,500 for safety improvement at the intersection of SW Condor Lane and Terwilliger Boulevard as part of the second phase of the Marquam Hill Traffic Calming Project in 2012.
- 2. OHSU has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for Phase II of the Marquam Hill Traffic Calming Project to PBOT in the amount of \$26,500.
- 3. The Marquam Hill Traffic Calming Plan, adopted by City Council Resolution No. 36519 on July 11, 2007, identified specific neighborhood traffic calming improvements.
- 4. The Phase I improvements were completed in 2008.
- PBOT will implement the Homestead Neighborhood Association's recommendations for safety improvements at SW Condor Lane and Terwilliger as Phase II of the Marquam Hill Traffic Calming Project.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Health Sciences University for the Marquam Hill Traffic Calming Project Phase II in the amount of \$26,500 and to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.
- b. The Marquam Hill Traffic Calming Project Phase II Project (T00219) and Grant (TR000073) are budgeted in the FY 11/12 budget.
- c. The Mayor is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.

d. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform and invoice OHSU for the activities authorized by the grant in FY 11/12; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
