

ORDINANCE No. 185468

* Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with the East Multnomah Soil & Water Conservation District through their Partners in Conservation Program for naturalist and job training program for teens (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Greenspaces Restoration and Urban Naturalist Team (GRUNT) is a naturalist and job training program for teens.
2. GRUNT is a pipeline to environmental careers. Teens are recruited from schools in diverse neighborhoods with 75% or greater Free and Reduced lunch participation.
3. The city benefits economically, culturally and environmentally from the GRUNT program. Teen participants learn about the plants, wildlife, watersheds and ecology of the Northwest, then earn a paycheck while working to protect them. They will be actively working to protect and improve local watersheds.
4. East Multnomah Soil & Water Conservation District (EMSWCD), through its Partners in Conservation Program, wishes to award \$33,399 to Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) in funding for this program for the 2012-13 year.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. The Director of Portland Parks & Recreation is hereby authorized to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement between Portland Parks & Recreation and the East Multnomah Soil & Water Conservation District to help fund the Greenspaces Restoration and Urban Naturalist Team (GRUNT) during the 2012 summer season.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid further delay in the provision of funding for the start of the GRUNT summer program; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
