7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

ATTORNEY ATTACHED:

This ordinance will approve a settlement of a lawsuit negotiated by the City Attorney's office brought by Marianne King who was injured in a fall on steps outside of the Starbucks on SW Broadway in Pioneer Courthouse Square. Settlement of the case prior to trial is recommended based on the costs of pursing the case and the potential that a jury would award Ms. King substantially more than the \$12,000 settlement.
