

ORDINANCE No. 185490

*Amend contract with Dignity Village to extend the contract terms for management of a transitional housing campground at Sunderland Yard (Ordinance, amend Contract No. 53015)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds

1. The City Council passed ordinance No. 180959 on May 16, 2007 authorizing a contract with Dignity Village, a nonprofit organization, to manage a transitional housing campground at Sunderland Yard.
2. Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) completed an evaluation of the campground, also called Dignity Village, in February 2010. The evaluation recommended many modifications to Contract C53015.
3. PHB requires additional time to meet with other City Bureaus, as well as Dignity Village stakeholders, therefore extending the contract terms to September 30, 2012 to determine the scope of a new contract with the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Bureau Director and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to revise contract C53015 with Dignity Village in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A (attached to original ordinance only).

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in executing the amendment would cause the current contract to expire prior to its execution; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


