

ORDINANCE No. 185508

* Authorize Intergovernmental Agreements with the Centennial School District, David Douglas School District, and Riverdale School District, to distribute one-time funding not to exceed \$1,576,929 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Education is one of the top four overarching goals of the City's Portland Plan; and,
2. The City of Portland and the Portland Development Commission's FY 2012-2013 Budgets include one-time funding for schools, including \$4.5 million of Business License revenues and \$500,000 from tax increment financing resources for Portland Public Schools, and \$2,137,365 of Business License revenues for other school districts whose catchments overlap with the boundaries of the City of Portland (hereafter, the "school districts") allocated by the Average Daily Membership weighted (ADMw) as defined in ORS 327.103; and
3. The school districts have agreed to take certain budgetary actions to direct their own funds to restore teachers and services that were cut, as described in the attached letters from each school district; and
4. City Council directed staff to prepare Intergovernmental Agreements with the school districts in Resolution # 36929.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into intergovernmental agreements in a form substantially in accordance with the intergovernmental agreements attached at a total cost not to exceed \$1,576,929.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2012-13 Adopted Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because school districts require funding to begin hiring teachers to keep continuity for students; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
