This is a personnel contract where the need is determined by available resources and the estimate is based on current expenditure levels. Reimbursement comes from each individual externally funded project. The original contract was \$500,000 over a 3-year period. A heavier use of temporary employees expired the authorization amount in the first year requiring a 25% increase of \$125,000. During the second year of the contract, the Federal ARRA projects arrived requiring additional staffing and a contract increase of \$1 million. The ARRA projects expired the contract authorization and an amendment of \$500,000 was approved to finish out the 3-year 2008-2011 contract. A new RFP solicitation process began in November 2011. The new solicitation process (QBS or Qualification Based Selection) required involvement from ODOT in order to become certified in the Ad-Bid-Award process for Consultant Services. The ODOT review process took much longer than expected. With the current QBS Solicitation process underway and advertised, we expect the new \$3M, 3-year contract to have Notice-To-Proceed by November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. A \$250k existing contract amendment is necessary to keep current contract employees working while the new contract gets negotiated and executed by November 1st.

We anticipate spending approximately \$850,000 in each year of the new 3-year contract.
