\* Authorize amendment for continued renewal for Grant Agreement No. 32000476 with the Native American Youth and Family Center for street-level gang outreach for Fiscal Year 2012 – 2013 to be retroactive from July 1, 2012. (Ordinance)

The purpose of the proposed legislation is to authorize a grant agreement, to provide street-level gang outreach service to high-risk gang-involved and gang associated youth and young adults up to the age of 25. The Native American Youth and Family Center (NAYA) has employed street level gang outreach workers through this program since May 2009, and their success is the reason the continued relationship is desired.
