The original contract amount was \$843,500; Change Orders 1 through 3 added \$401,365.55 to the contract, making the final contract amount \$1,244,865.55. The final amount expended on this contract is \$1,199,782.22. The actual cost is 42.24% over the original contract amount for the project. The final payment to be made in the amount of \$59,989.11 is for release of retainage.

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) funding was awarded for this project, administered via the Oregon Infrastructure Finance Authority. This funding included a forgivable loan of \$650,000 and low-interest loan of \$650,000, for a total of \$1,300,000. The City has been reimbursed for the forgivable loan amount of \$650,000.
