

# ORDINANCE No. 185546

\*Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$100,000 from East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District for Crystal Springs Railroad Culvert Replacement & Restoration (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) applied to EMSWCD for a grant in the amount of \$100,000 for Crystal Springs Railroad Culvert Replacement & Restoration on January 16, 2012; and
2. EMSWCD has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for Crystal Springs Railroad Culvert Replacement & Restoration to BES in the amount of \$100,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from EMSWCD for Crystal Springs Railroad Culvert Replacement & Restoration in the amount of \$100,000.
- b. The FY 2012/2013 budget is hereby amended as follows:  
GRANTS FUND  
Fund 217  
Business Areas – ES  
Bureau Program Expenses– \$100,000
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of BES of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by EMSWCD for Crystal Springs Railroad Culvert Replacement & Restoration, PIC-12-011, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
