The State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) supports the implementation of state and local homeland security strategies to address the identified planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs to prepare for, respond to and recover from and natural or man-made disaster.

The Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) will apply to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for an SHSGP FY 2012 grant in the amount of \$48,707.
