## ORDINANCE No. 185590

\* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$49,675 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, National Institute of Justice for the FY 2012 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grants Program for approved digital imaging project expenses (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City applied to the U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ) Office of Justice Programs (OJP), National Institute of Justice (NIJ) for the FY 2012 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grants Program on May 16, 2012; and
- 2. The USDOJ OJP NIJ has notified the City that it will award a grant for the FY 2012 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grants Program to the City in the amount of \$49,675; and
- 3. The USDOJ will reimburse the City a maximum of \$49,675 for approved digital imaging project expenses incurred by the Police Bureau; and
- 4. The award documents must be signed by the Mayor and submitted to OJP by September 21, 2012, in order not to lose funding; and
- 5. No match is required by this grant; and
- 6. The grant period is October 1, 2012, through September 30, 2013.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from USDOJ OJP NIJ for the FY 2012 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grants Program in the amount of \$49,675.
- b. The FY 2012-13 budget is hereby amended as follows:

## **GRANTS FUND**

Fund - 217

Business Area - PL

Bureau Program Expenses - \$49,675

c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the USDOJ for the FY 2012 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grants Program, #2012-CD-BX-0031, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funding. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
