ORDINANCE No. 185604

*Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$1,500,000 from Oregon Department of Transportation for the Active Corridor Management project, to install ITS equipment, air quality equipment, and optimize traffic signal timing along various corridors east of I-205. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) applied to Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) for a grant in the amount of \$1,500,000, for the installation of fiber, CCTV cameras, Bluetooth readers, air quality monitoring devices, vehicular traffic and bike monitoring stations, and fiber optics along various corridors east of I-205 on 5/13/2010; and
- 2. ODOT has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Active Corridor Management to PBOT in the amount of \$1,500,000.00, there is no local match required;
- 3. City staff will use the newly installed devices to monitor traffic, relieve congestion, enhance safety, and increase efficiency of the existing transportation system.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from ODOT for the Active Corridor Management project in the amount of \$1,500,000.00, and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2012/2013 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund: 217 Business Area – TR Bureau Program Expenses– \$1,500,000

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of PBOT of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by ODOT for Active Corridor Management grant, award number 28591, provided such modifications do not increase the City of

e. Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
