

ORDINANCE No. 185614

\* Authorize application to the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police for a grant in the amount of \$70,000 for the 2013 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement program for sworn personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Oregon Association Chiefs of Police (OACP) makes awards to Oregon law enforcement agencies for the DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) program; and
2. The City of Portland, Oregon Police Bureau wishes to apply for OACP grant funding. Traffic Division sworn personnel will provide direct enforcement; and
3. The OACP will reimburse the City a maximum of \$70,000 for expenses incurred by the bureau for Traffic Division sworn personnel overtime hours worked on the 2013 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) program. The reimbursement rate is \$50.00 per hour; and
4. The local match may include any agency resources used to support the overtime activity, including scheduling and report compilation, as well as straight-time enforcement. Local match shall be provided from City funds in the form of personnel expenses (straight time hours in support of DUII enforcement, overtime expenses incurred above the grant's \$50.00 per hour reimbursement rate and all benefit expenses related to the grant's straight time and overtime in the Police Bureau's FY 2012-13 and FY 2013-14 budgets. The estimated minimum match is \$109,739; and
5. The grant period is October 1, 2012, through September 30, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to OACP for a grant in the amount of \$70,000 in a form substantially in accordance with the application attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this application may result in not receiving program funding. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
