



Existing Conditions Plan - Overall Site












Proposed Improvements Plan -South Parking Lot















Site Furnishings Sections and Details - 1









GENERAL ROCKWORK INSTALLATION NOTES:

- PLACE BASALT MOSS BOULDERS IN CLUSTERS OF VARYING SIZE AS INDICATED IN KEY. ALL
 BASALT COLUMNS AND SLABS TO HAVE NATURAL WEATHERED TOP AND EXPOSED SIDES WITH
 SMOOTH SAWCUT BOTTOMS AND ABUTTING SIDES.
- 2. AVOID DAMAGE TO BOULDERS AND COLUMNS DURING TRANSPORT, HANDLING, AND PLACEMENT. BASALT MATERIAL WILL BE INSPECTED PRIOR TO PLACEMENT AND DAMAGED MATERIAL WILL BE REJECTED.
- 3. SAW CUT BASALT COLUMNS TO FIT TIGHT IN A NATURAL CONFIGURATION WHEN BUTTED NEXT TO EACH OTHER. FILL JOINTS WITH GROUT OR EPOXY AS INDICATED WHERE JOINTS ARE NOT VISIBLE.
- 4. HORIZOTAL BASALT SLABS TO BE SAW CUT FLAT ON THE BOTTOM SIDE. PLACE CUT FACE ON LEVEL, SMOOTH, PAVED SURFACE WITHOUT ROCKING.
- $5.\,REMOVE$ ALL SHARP EDGES AND POINTS FROM ALL ROCKWORK AND BOULDERS; GRIND OR CHISEL SHARP PROTRUSIONS.





GENERAL PLANTING NOTES:

- 1. PROTECT EXISTING TREES TO REMAIN FROM CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS. DO NOT ENCROACH UPON, FILL, OR OTHERWISE DISTURB THE AREA WITHIN THE DRIPLINE OF TREES OR SHRUBS TO BE PRESERVED.
- 2. STOCKPILE EXISTING TOPSOIL FOR USE IN THE LANDSCAPE BEDS AND INSTALL TEMPORARY SILT FENCING AROUND STOCKPILES. USE STOCKPILED TOPSOIL FOR LANDSCAPE WORK AND AMEND AS SPECIFIED PRIOR TO USE IN PLANT PITS AND BEDS. SUBGRADE SOILS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR USE IN LANDSCAPE WORK.
- 3. CHECK AND CONFIRM PLANT QUANTITIES. PLANT TREES AND SHRUBS IN LOCATIONS SHOWN, SPACED TO COMPLETELY FILL BEDS WITH THE QUANTITIES INDICATED IN THE PLANT LIST(S).
- 4. CONTRACTOR TO SECURE AVAILABILITY OF PLANT MATERIAL SIX MONTHS PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF WORK.
- 5. MULCH ALL PLANTS AND BEDS WITH 3" COMPOSTED GARDEN MULCH PRODUCT. BARK CHIPS OR DUST ARE NOT
- 6. SEE SPECIFICATIONS FOR LAWN SEED AND VEGETATED STORMWATER FACILITY SEEDING.
- 7. STAKE ALL TREE LOCATIONS FOR REVIEW BY PROJECT ENGINEER PRIOR TO PLANTING.
- 8. PLANT MATERIAL TO BE MAINTAINED AND GUARANTEED AFTER COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT FOR A PERIOD OF 2 YEARS.
 REMOVE NOXIOUS AND INVASIVE SPECIES AND MAINTAIN WEED CONTROL FOR THE DURATION OF THE 2-YEAR GUARANTEE PERIOD. SEE SPECIFICATIONS FOR REQUIREMENTS OF THE PLANT MAINTENANCE AND GUARANTEE PERIOD.

STORMWATER FACILITY PLANTING NOTES:

- 1. PROVIDE 18" DEPTH OF GROWING MEDIUM MEETING SPECIFICATIONS IN CITY OF PORTLAND STORMWATER MANUAL APPENDIX F-3, OR EQUAL PARTS SAND/ LOAM/ 3-WAY COMPOST MIX. DO NOT COMPACT.
- 2. SUBMIT GROWING MEDIUM SAMPLE, SUPPLIER, SOURCE, AND ANALYSIS INFORMATION FOR APPROVAL PRIOR TO DELIVERY.



Landscape Details



THE GOAL OF THE PROPOSED REVEGETATION PROJECT IS TO ENHANCE THE DIVERSITY AND DENSITY OF NATIVE SHRUB SPECIES IN THE TARGETED AREA OF THE PARK. CURRENTLY THE NATIVE VEGETATION AT THIS LOCATION IS DOMINATED BY ONLY TWO SPECIES: *SALIX LASIANDRA* (PACIFIC WILLOW) AND *CORNUS SERICEA* (RED TWIG DOGWOOD). NEW NATIVE SHRUBS WILL BE INTERMIXED WITH EXISTING VEGETATION AND DISTRIBUTED WITHIN THE DESIGNATED PLANTING AREA SHOWN ON PLAN—WILLAMETTE GREENWAY PLANTING AREA. THIS AREA INCLUDES THE WILLAMETTE RIVERBANK AND THE MUDFLAT BELOW THE BANK.

PLAN - WILLAMETTE GREENWAY PLANTING AREA









North and Central Parking Lot Areas Landscaping Review





















Figure 6.4-6.7









