ORDINANCE No. 185643

* Authorize a competitive solicitation for recycling, composting and garbage hauling services for City-owned and operated facilities (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. City Bureaus require regular recycling, composting and garbage hauling services to be performed at various locations throughout the City.
- 2. In 2008, as part of the City's Strategic Sourcing initiative, and in order to maximize resource efficiency and cost savings, the City consolidated the procurement of recycling, composting and garbage removal services.
- 3. The City's current contract for recycling, composting, and garbage removal services for City facilities will expire on February 7, 2013.
- 4. The estimated not-to-exceed cost for these services is \$1,800,000 over a three-year period, with option to amend for funding for two additional years. Costs for each location will be funded from the individual bureaus' (Office of Management and Finance Facilities Services, Portland Parks and Recreation, Fire Bureau, Portland Water Bureau, Portland Bureau of Transportation Bureau of Maintenance, and the Bureau of Environmental Services) adopted budgets for each fiscal year.
- 5. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability seeks Council authorization for Procurement Services to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process to obtain the most responsible and responsive offer providing a not-to-exceed contract for \$1,800,000.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report on the selection process, Procurement Services is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that there be no delay in providing services, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


