The City of Gresham and Portland desire to enter into agreements to provide financing for Portland to take lead responsibility for coordination of the inter-jurisdictional 2011-2016 Consortium Consolidated Plan updates and one-year Action Plans 2013-14, as well as other plans and performance reports as requested of the Consortium by HUD during FY 2012-2013.

The City of Gresham has agreed to reimburse PHB \$10,000 in CBDG for FY 2012-2013 for coordination of the 2011-2016 Consolidated Plan Amendments, updated Analysis of Impediments Action Plan, and Action Plans FY 2013-2014. This amount was included in PHB's FY 2012-13 base budgets.
