## ORDINANCE No. 185667

\*Authorize two Ground Lease Agreements with the Portland Development Commission for construction staging related to the Foster-Woodstock Streetscape Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. After a competitive process, Kodiak Construction was selected as the General Contractor for the Foster-Woodstock Streetscape Project.
- 2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) desires to provide Kodiak Construction with an area suitable for their use for construction staging of materials and supplies.
- 3. The Portland Development Commission (PDC) owns two parcels of land that meet these needs adjacent to the project area (Exhibit A 92nd Street Dance Club and Exhibit B Tate House).
- 4. PDC and PBOT have agreed to the terms and conditions by which PDC will lease the sites to PBOT, who will make the sites available to Kodiak Construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Council hereby authorizes the Director of the Bureau of Transportation to enter into two Ground Lease Agreements with the Portland Development Commission, substantially in accordance with the agreements attached to this Ordinance as Exhibits A and B.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the construction schedule requires this to be executed in a timely manner; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
