## ORDINANCE No.

\* Accept a grant in the amount of \$70,000 and appropriate \$55,000 for FY 2012-13 from the Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division 2013 Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program for sworn personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the 2013 Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program (DISP) to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$70,000; and
- 2. The ODOT project will fund the Police Bureau Traffic Division to assist the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program in order to provide direct law enforcement capability to the court-based probation program. The primary function of the sworn members will be to conduct warrant sweeps; and
- 3. The Oregon Department of Transportation will reimburse the City a maximum of \$70,000 for sworn personnel overtime expenses incurred by the Police Bureau Traffic Division; and
- 4. Local match in the amount of \$210,008 will be provided by funds from FY 2012-13 and FY 2013-14 bureau program budget appropriations; and
- 5. The grant period is October 1, 2012, through September 30, 2013; and
- 6. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOT.

# NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the 2013 Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program in the amount of \$70,000.
- b. The FY 2012-13 budget is hereby amended as follows:

### **GRANTS FUND**

Fund - 217 Business Area - PL Bureau Program Expenses - \$55,000

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Oregon Department of Transportation for the 2013 Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program, 164AL-13-14-17, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOT. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
