

ORDINANCE No. 185675

*Authorize application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency Community Resilience Innovation Challenge Grant for an award in the amount of \$35,000 to fund additional equipment for the Neighborhood Emergency Communication Sites. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The goal of FEMA's Community Resilience Innovation Challenge grant for 2012 is to foster community resilience by identifying needs; mobilizing partners; and creating innovative, motivational, and effective solutions that can be grown, sustained, and replicated.
2. The Portland Bureau of Emergency Management will use approved funding to procure additional equipment for the Neighborhood Emergency Communication Sites.
3. No match is required by this grant.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency Community Resilience Innovation Challenge Grant for an award in the amount of \$35,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in that any delay in the application for this grant will result in losing the opportunity for funding these activities; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
