## ORDINANCE No. 185686

\*Extend contract with CMTS LLC to add contractual spending authority and extend termination date to provide qualified temporary Inspection and Engineering Technician personnel (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30001969)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) entered into a 3-year flexible services contract with contractor CMTS LLC to provide qualified temporary Inspection and Engineering Technician personnel during peak seasonal workload demands.
- 2. The original contract with a not-to-exceed amount of \$500,000 was to expire on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012. An amendment to increase the spending authority by \$125,000 was approved in May 2010 as peak work loads required additional spending.
- 3. A contractual spending increase of \$1,000,000 was approved by Council in June 2010 to assist PBOT in meeting the increased workload demands from ARRA projects.
- 4. A formal solicitation advertised in September 2012 under the new QBS selection process was unsuccessful in securing a new contract.
- 5. A contractual spending increase is needed for the current contract with a not-to-exceed amount of \$500,000 and a revised contract termination date of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2013, to allow time to conduct a new solicitation.
- 6. Services will be paid for from current budgeted projects.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute the proposed amendment, which has been approved by the City Attorney as to form, substantially in accordance with the amendment attached to the original of this ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because employees are currently working on bureau projects under the existing contract and need to continue without delay; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
