## ORDINANCE No. 185696

\* Accept a grant in the amount of \$36,000 and appropriate \$27,000 for FY 2012-13 from the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police 2013 Safety Belt Enforcement Program for sworn personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Association Chiefs of Police (OACP) has notified the City that it will award a grant for the 2013 Safety Belt Enforcement Program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$36,000; and
- 2. The project will fund the Police Bureau Traffic Division's direct enforcement and educational training of Oregon's occupant restraint laws towards the State's goal of reducing traffic crash fatality and injury rates; and
- 3. The OACP will reimburse the City a maximum of \$36,000 for sworn personnel overtime hours worked on the 2013 Safety Belt Enforcement program. The reimbursement rate is \$50.00 per hour; and
- 4. This grant requires a local match of two hours straight time enforcement for every one hour of overtime worked enforcing occupant restraint laws. Local match shall be provided from City funds in the form of personnel expenses (straight time hours in support of occupant restraint enforcement, overtime expenses incurred above the grant's \$50.00 per hour reimbursement rate and all benefit expenses related to the grant's straight time and overtime in the Police Bureau's FY 2012-13 and FY 2013-14 budgets. The estimated minimum match is \$56,437; and
- 5. The grant period is October 1, 2012, through September 30, 2013; and
- 6. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from OACP.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from OACP for the 2013 Safety Belt Enforcement Program in the amount of \$36,000.
- b. The FY 2012-13 budget is hereby amended as follows:

  GRANTS FUND
  Fund 217
  Business Area PL

Bureau Program Expenses - \$27,000

- The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all c. administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by OACP for the 2013 Safety Belt Enforcement Program provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from OACP. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
