- 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS: Ordinance Number 185593 passed by the Council on September 5, 2012 authorized a contract and provided payment for the construction of the NE Klickitat Neighborhood Greenway project. The purpose of this project is to improve stormwater management, pedestrian safety, and bicycle movement.
- 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT: The Engineer's estimate for this project was \$980,000.00 with a high confidence rating. Funds are available in the BES Sewer System Operation Fund, FY 2012-2013.
- 9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED: Accept Recommendation to award contract to Landis & Landis Construction, LLC, in the amount of \$1,097,705.56.
- 10. <u>SCOPE OF WORK ON PROJECT:</u> The project includes all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and supervision necessary to improve existing water lines, construct approximately 750 feet of new combined sewer lines, and create stormwater swales at several locations in inner NE and Central NE Portland.
