

ORDINANCE No. 185700

Accept a grant in the amount of \$90,000 from Oregon Department of Transportation to develop and implement specific efforts to improve transportation safety on ten high crash corridors, and to work with the Metro Traffic Safety Workgroup to support transportation safety efforts in the Portland metropolitan area. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Bureau of Transportation applied to Oregon Department of Transportation for a Safe Community Grant in the amount of \$90,000 to develop and implement specific efforts to improve transportation safety on the high crash corridors of W Burnside, SE Sandy Boulevard, SE Powell Boulevard, SW Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway, SE Division Street, N/NE Marine Drive, SE Foster Road, 122nd Avenue, SW Barbur Boulevard, and NE/SE 82nd Avenue and to work with the Metro Traffic Safety Workgroup to support transportation safety efforts in the Portland metropolitan area on September 19, 2012; and
2. Oregon Department of Transportation has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the development and implementation of specific efforts to improve transportation safety on the high crash corridors of W Burnside, SE Sandy Boulevard, SE Powell Boulevard, SW Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway, SE Division Street, N/NE Marine Drive, SE Foster Road, 122nd Avenue, SW Barbur Boulevard, and NE/SE 82nd Avenue and to work with the Metro Traffic Safety Workgroup to support transportation safety efforts in the Portland metropolitan area to Bureau of Transportation in the amount of \$90,000 effective October 1, 2012.
3. Portland Bureau of Transportation has budgeted this grant in TR000175 in the FY 12-13 Adopted Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the development and implementation of specific efforts to improve transportation safety on the high crash corridors of W Burnside, SE Sandy Boulevard, SE Powell Boulevard, SW Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway, SE Division Street, N/NE Marine Drive, SE Foster Road, 122nd Avenue, SW Barbur Boulevard, and NE/SE 82nd Avenue and to work with the Metro Traffic Safety Workgroup to support transportation safety efforts in the Portland metropolitan area in the amount of \$90,000.
