ORDINANCE No. 185704

* Accept a grant in the amount of \$80,000, appropriate \$33,000 for FY 2012-13 and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Justice Crime Victims' Services Division for Crisis Response Team personnel expenses (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the Oregon Department of Justice (ODOJ) Crime Victims' Services Division (CVSD) for a grant in the amount of \$80,000 for the 2012-14 VOCA Non-competitive Grant on May 2, 2012; and
- 2. The purpose of the agreement, #VOCA-NC-2012-PPB-0020, is for ODOJ CVSD to provide funds to the City so the Police Bureau Crisis Response Team may fund a 0.65 FTE Crisis Response Team Senior Administrative Specialist/Volunteer Coordinator for 24 months; and
- 3. The ODOJ will reimburse the City for approved personnel expenses for 65 percent of the personnel expenses for the Crisis Response Team's Senior Administrative Specialist/Volunteer Coordinator in the amount of \$40,000 per two 12-month periods for an amount not to exceed \$80,000; and
- 4. Required local match in the amount of \$20,000 will be provided by funds from existing Police Bureau appropriation within Youth Services Division in Fiscal Years 2013, 2014 and 2015; and
- 5. The grant period is October 1, 2012, through September 30, 2014; and
- 6. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOJ.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City a grant from the Oregon Department of Justice Crime Victims' Services Division for the 2012-14 VOCA Non-competitive Grant in the amount of \$80,000.
- c. The FY 2012-13 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANTS FUND</u>

Fund - 217

Business Area – PL

Bureau Program Expenses - \$33,000

- d. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- e. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Oregon Department of Justice for the 2012-14 VOCA Non-competitive Grant, #VOCA-NC-2012-PPB-00020, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOJ. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
