Authorize the Office of Management and Finance (OMF) to Exchange Real Property with Legacy Emanuel Hospital and Health Center as pertaining to Abends Addition, Block 1, Lot 1-9 Tax Lot 700, in Portland, Oregon ("the Kerby Lot") owned by the City and Proebstels Addition, Block 15, east 33 1/3 feet of Lots 9 and 10 owned by Legacy (Ordinance)

Surplus the Kerby Lot and authorize the Office of Management and Finance (OMF) to convey the Kerby Lot to Legacy Emanuel Hospital and Health Center ("Legacy") for consideration \$1,100,000 in cash, ten annual payments of \$53,700, and conveyance of Legacy property to the City along with additional consideration including a five year parking easement to stage City fleet and equipment and materials and supplies in an event of a City emergency.
