

I. RECOMMENDATION

Approve and Forward for Council action a new pretreatment program implementation services agreement with Clean Water Services (CWS).

II. BACKGROUND

The City and CWS (then known as the Unified Sewerage Agency) first entered into a wholesale sewer service agreement in April 1978, and signed a second agreement in May 1998 (Ordinance #172285), which was amended in 2000 for pretreatment issues.

The two parties have agreed to a replacement agreement, and have decided to break out the pretreatment piece in a separate agreement for flexibility and ease of future amendments if necessary.
