

ORDINANCE No. 185710

* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$10,337 for FY 2012-13 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY12 Bulletproof Vest Partnership/Body Armor Safety Initiative for bulletproof vests (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City applied to the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for the FY12 Bulletproof Vest Partnership/Body Armor Safety Initiative grant on June 13, 2012; and
2. The DOJ has notified the City that it will award a grant for the FY12 Bulletproof Vest Partnership/Body Armor Safety Initiative to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$10,337.34; and
3. The DOJ will reimburse the City a maximum of \$10,337.34 for expenses incurred for the purchase of 15 Threat Level III-A bulletproof vests for Police Bureau sworn personnel with the rank of officer through lieutenant (per Bureau Directive 1110.00 - Body Armor) whose vests are due for replacement. The award amount was based on the overall number of grant requests received by DOJ; and
4. Local match in the amount of \$10,337.34 will be provided by funds from FY12 bureau program budget appropriations; and
5. The grant period is April 1, 2012, through August 31, 2014;
6. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from DOJ.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City a grant from the DOJ for the FY12 Bulletproof Vest Partnership/Body Armor Safety Initiative in the amount of \$10,337.34.
- b. The FY 2012-13 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217

Business Area - PL

Bureau Program Expenses - \$10,337.34

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by the U.S. Department of Justice for the FY12 Bulletproof Vest Partnership/Body Armor Safety Initiative provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from DOJ. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


