Amendment to  
City of Portland and Multnomah Drainage District No. 1,  
Peninsula Drainage District No. 1, and Peninsula Drainage District No. 2  
Intergovernmental Agreement for Stormwater Management Services

**Recitals**

- A. The above-cited intergovernmental agreement ("the IGA") was entered into by and between the City of Portland ("the City"), as represented by its Bureau of Environmental Services, and Multnomah County Drainage District No. 1 (portion within City of Portland boundaries), Peninsula Drainage District No. 1, and Peninsula Drainage District No. 2 (collectively, "the Districts").
- B. The parties to the IGA wish to extend its term.


**Terms**

1. On December 26, 2006, the City provided written notice to the Districts of the City's intent to terminate the IGA. Per the terms of the IGA, it would have then remained in effect through June 30, 2012. However, the City and Districts have subsequently agreed to extend the IGA for one additional year. The IGA will now terminate on June 30, 2013.
2. All other terms and conditions shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
3. This contract amendment may be signed in two (2) or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same contract amendment.






