* Amend the City Deferred Compensation Plan to allow Roth 457 and auto-enrollment opportunity (Ordinance; amend Code Chapter 5.09)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The IRS recently allowed and the Deferred Compensation Advisory Committee has approved adding a Roth 457 savings option effective January 1, 2013.
- 2. It is necessary for the City to add language in sections of the Plan to adopt a Roth Savings option.
- 3. The State of Oregon allows auto-enrollment of deferred compensation contributions through collective bargaining agreements.
- 4. The Deferred Compensation Advisory Committee has approved adding the opportunity for autoenrollment of deferred compensation contributions through collective bargaining agreements.
- 5. It is necessary for the City to add language in sections of the Plan to allow for the opportunity to implement Auto-Enroll contributions to the City 457 Deferred Compensation Plan.
- 6. These revisions to the Plan are desirable and should be implemented.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. City Code Chapter 5.09 Deferred Compensation Plan is amended in accordance with Exhibit 1 effective November 14, 2012.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that deferred compensation participants can make election of these provisions with no delay; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
