

ORDINANCE No. 185731

* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$267,609 from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for Portland Fire & Rescue related to the City's Metropolitan Medical Response System for the Antidote Replacement Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. The Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management (OEM) has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Antidote Replacement Project to Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) in the amount of \$267,609; and
2. No matching funds are required.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for the Antidote Replacement Project in the amount of \$267,609.
- b. The FY 2012/2013 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND
Fund 217
Business Area – FR
Bureau Program Expenses– \$267,609
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Fire Chief of Portland Fire & Rescue, of the City of Portland, is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for MMRS 2011 grant, award number 11-181, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


