

ORDINANCE No. **185743**

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for the maintenance and repair services of Multnomah County vehicles (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Public works vehicles have specific performance requirements which require specialized service and maintenance work.
2. The City of Portland's CityFleet provides specialized maintenance and repairs to its own fleet to meet the needs of the City of Portland. CityFleet has provided maintenance and repair to other local governmental entities. CityFleet is recognized as a leader in the fleet industry for its technical and mechanical capability.
3. Multnomah County wishes to engage the services of CityFleet pursuant to an intergovernmental agreement and to compensate Portland for its maintenance and repair services.
4. Providing maintenance and repair services to Multnomah County is in Portland's interest and promotes amicable relationships with other governmental entities. Providing such services will not negatively impact CityFleet's ability to effectively and efficiently support the vehicle administrative needs of Portland's bureaus and divisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. An intergovernmental agreement to provide maintenance and repair to Multnomah County is hereby approved in substantially the form attached hereto in the IGA as Exhibit A. The Commissioner in Charge of the Office of Management and Finance is hereby authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement in substantially the form attached hereto and as approved to form by the City Attorney.
