Support the Oregon Passenger Rail project including improvements in intercity passenger rail service in the Pacific Northwest corridor (Resolution)

- WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is studying options for improved passenger rail service from the Eugene-Springfield area and Vancouver Washington; and
- WHEREAS, this 125-mile segment is part of the federally designated Pacific Northwest Rail Corridor; and
- WHEREAS, ODOT is leading an environmental process that will inform a number of important decisions, including selection of the general rail alignment and communities where stations would be located; and
- WHEREAS, this project will also determine several service characteristics including number of daily trips, travel time objectives and technologies to be used; and
- WHEREAS, ODOT has formed a Leadership Council to oversee the environmental process, which includes as a member the Mayor of Portland.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council acknowledges the Alternative Concept Diagram, attached as Exhibit A, as a reference document that illustrates passenger rail alignments that were suggested during a public scoping for the environmental impact statement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council supports short-term and long-term improvements in intercity passenger rail service between Eugene-Springfield and Vancouver, British Columbia; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council supports planning for improvements in local transit service over time that would complement the improvements in intercity passenger rail service including faster transit travel times and increased frequency of service; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council directs the Bureau of Transportation and Bureau of Planning and Sustainability to consider the passenger rail alignments as a reference document to inform future planning.
