

ORDINANCE No. 185817

* Amend an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to extend the FFY 2011 Intellectual Property Crime Enforcement Program grant period in order to reimburse the County for a Deputy District Attorney (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002306)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City entered into Contract 30002306 on March 14, 2012, with Multnomah County (County) to use the services of the Multnomah County District Attorney's Office to perform services related to prosecuting intellectual property crimes;
2. The original Contract authorized the City to reimburse the County for the cost of approved program expenses for a 0.5 FTE Deputy District Attorney not to exceed \$89,913 by the grant end date September 30, 2012. The City received a grant extension from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs and now requires an extension to the Intergovernmental Agreement;
3. The City wishes to amend the Interagency Agreement by extending the end date to the current federal closeout date of March 31, 2013, unless earlier terminated in accordance with the Agreement; and
4. Funding for this project was included in the Bureau's FY 2012-13 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to amend Contract 30002306 substantially in accordance with the Agreement Amendment #1 attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by the U.S. Department of Justice for the FFY 2011 Intellectual Property Crime Enforcement Program Grant, #2011-BE-BX-0003, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this authorization will delay the City and County from receiving the mutual benefits of this Agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
