**ORDINANCE NO. 185823**

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland Public Schools for Installation of Water Efficiency Devices (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Water Bureau, through the Water Efficiency Program, provides water conservation information and technical resources to all of its customers. The main objective of the conservation program is to help customers use water efficiently and cost-effectively.
2. The City's Business, Industry, and Government Program, in the Water Bureau's Water Efficiency Program, has worked for many years helping Portland Public Schools reduce their water use.
3. The City is highly committed to assisting Portland Public Schools to provide quality education to Portland students. Helping them reduce their water/sewer bills by becoming more water efficient will provide more funds for education.
4. There are opportunities for Portland Public Schools to change out water-cooled equipment with air-cooled equipment; to reduce any single pass cooling; and to change out high water use fixtures with more efficient ones.
5. The not to exceed value of this agreement is \$20,000. Funding for this agreement is available in the FY 2012-13 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Water Bureau Administrator is authorized to execute on behalf of the City an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland Public Schools in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
