7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

This ordinance would settle a lawsuit brought in state court by Ms. Lesley Barnes against the City of Portland for bodily injury suffered when her vehicle was struck from the rear by a vehicle driven by a Portland Fire Inspector on December 10, 2009. Previously, payment was made to Ms. Barnes' insurance company State Farm to reimburse them for payments they made to pay for medical bills and car repairs. This settlement amount of \$4000 will be paid to Ms. Barnes and her attorney Jeffrey Bowersox for non-economic damages including pain and suffering.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$4,000 from the liability fund.
