ORDINANCE No. 185848

*Adopt a Waste Reduction Program and accept and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro to receive Metro Waste Reduction Challenge Funds of \$272,505 and \$282,500 for the Recycle at Work Program in FY 12-13 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Metro has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant of Metro Waste Reduction Challenge Funds and the Recycle at Work Program in FY 12-13 to Bureau of Planning and Sustainability in the amount of \$272,505 and \$282,500.
- 2. Funds continue to support mutual regional and citywide goals for improved efforts in waste reduction and recycling volume.
- 3. The funding is appropriated in the FY 2012-13 Adopted Budget for the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from Metro for the Metro and Local Government Annual Waste Reduction Program and the Recycle at Work Program in the amount of \$272,505 and \$282,500 and to sign an intergovernmental agreement in substantially the form of the attached Exhibit A for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2012-13 budget is hereby amended as follows:

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Metro for grant award number 931701, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.
