ORDINANCE No. 185853

Accept donation of 3G Modems from Legacy Health (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Legacy Health (Legacy) made a decision to focus on cardiac care of patients in the greater Portland Metropolitan area, including obtaining emergent patient data EKG's and vital signs in real time.
- 2. In order to obtain the information, Legacy is providing modems to its EMS partners in the area, so they can transmit the necessary information.
- 3. Implementation of this program will help ensure a better outcome for most cardiac patients.
- 4. Dr. Jui and the Multnomah County Health Department have approved this program for its EMS providers.
- 5. The Gresham and Lake Oswego Fire Departments have already initiated this program.
- 6. The approximate value of the donation is \$28,000.
- 7. The Fire Chief recommends that the Council accept the donation from Legacy Health.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The City Council accepts the donation of the 3G Modems for Portland Fire & Rescue, and thanks Legacy Health for its donation.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the sooner the modems are put into use the greater the potential to save more lives in the Portland Metropolitan area; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
