#### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The purpose of this legislation is to ratify the LOA the City has reached with five of the six labor organizations that participate in the LMBC that amends each collective bargaining agreement by adding one AFSCME, Local 189-3 bargaining unit representative and one additional City representative to the LMBC. The participating labor organizations include COPPEA, PPCOA, Recreation; BOEC, and the member unions of the DCTU. Although PFFA is also a member labor organization of the LMBC, the City did not enter into an LOA with PFFA because the addition of one City representative and one AFSCME, Local 189-3 representative was included in the PFFA labor agreement for July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2016.
