

ORDINANCE No. 185861

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement for 2013-15 with Portland State University in the amount of \$127,139 to implement the Single Family Weight Study for Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Both the State of Oregon and the City of Portland have adopted aggressive waste reduction goals that rely on increasing recycling for all sectors, including residential, multifamily and commercial.
2. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) has entered into prior intergovernmental agreements with Portland State University (PSU) to conduct studies of residential disposal weights. PSU has conducted on-route weighing of residential garbage containers in Portland since 1992, when franchising began. BPS uses this data for solid waste ratemaking purposes.
3. PSU will provide services to BPS to determine amounts by weight of garbage being collected at the curbside of single family residences.
4. The IGA will be effective as of January 1, 2013 and will continue in effect for a two-year period until January 31, 2015. Funds are available in the adopted FY 2012-2013 budget of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, SAP Code PNSD000006. Additional funds are to be appropriated for the remainder of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE,

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement in a total amount of \$127,139 with PSU in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A to this Ordinance.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to the Solid Waste Management Fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- c. The Director of Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications to the agreement provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.


