

ORDINANCE No.

185867

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Upper Hillsdale Sub-Basin RDII Pilot Project . BES Project No. E10472 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In 2012 Council adopted Resolution 36977 recognizing the negative impacts of Rainfall Derived Infiltration and Inflow (RDII), and endorsing implementation of RDII pilot projects.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for the first of the pilot projects to rehabilitate the deteriorated sewer pipes and service laterals from the sewer mainline to the house connection to mitigate RDII, and extending a portion of sewer to provide better service.
3. Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for this project.
4. The estimated cost is \$ 2,350,000. The level of confidence in this estimate is "High". Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2012-2013 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10472.C60, and the current & future years requested Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
