Adopt Resolution honoring the life and public service of Art DeMuro to the City of Portland (Resolution)

WHEREAS Art DeMuro has resided in Portland, Oregon since 1991, and was the founder of Venerable Group, Inc., a firm involved in the preservation and revitalization of Oregon's historic building heritage and resources, and

WHEREAS since his residency within our City, Art DeMuro became a recognized leader in Portland's historic preservation and real estate development community, and

WHEREAS Art DeMuro was personally committed to the success of preserving and revitalizing Oregon's historic resources, and

WHEREAS Art DeMuro was responsible for the preservation and adaptive reuse of many historic properties which might otherwise have been demolished, and

WHEREAS Art DeMuro was a mentor to many within our community, worked tirelessly to educate others about the benefits of historic structure reuse, built consensus through understanding, and was an individual of great integrity, patience, and kindness, and

WHEREAS Art DeMuro was an invaluable, innovative, inspirational, and highly respected, member of the Portland Historic Landmarks Commission, serving from 2001 through 2011, three years of which as its Chair, and

WHEREAS, through Art DeMuro's participation and leadership on the Portland Historic Landmarks Commission, the citizens of Portland have benefitted from, and will continue to enjoy, this City's historic and architectural heritage, and

WHERAS, Art DeMuro died on September 8, 2012, and

WHEREAS, on October 9, 2012, the Portland Historic Landmarks Commission adopted a Resolution honoring Art DeMuro, including a recommendation to the City Council of Portland, Oregon that an award or other lasting memorial be made in the name of Art DeMuro.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Portland City Council formally recognizes and acknowledges the exemplary and lasting work of Art DeMuro as a member of the Portland Historic Landmarks Commission, and citizen of our community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Portland City Council sends it condolences to the DeMuro family on the death of Art DeMuro.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of Portland, Oregon formally request the Portland Historic Landmarks Commission to submit, for its consideration, suggestions for an award or other lasting memorial in the name of Art DeMuro.
